## Prayer Station 2

- Give thanks for who God is and what He gives us.
- Think about times you've seen or felt God's faithfulness in your life.

Prayer Station 3

*Your kingdom come, Your will be  
done on earth as it is in heaven.*

- Reflect on what it means to acknowledge God as king over your life, and all our lives.
- Ask for our homes and churches to become places where more people of all ages discover God's love and mercy.



# *Praying the Lord's Prayer*

Prayer Station 4

*Give us today our daily bread.*

- Think about the things God has provided for you, and thank Him for that.
- Pray for those who are vulnerable in our parish and community to be reached by God's love.
- Ask for God's provision for all those working to bring in His kingdom in our parish and community.





# *Praying the Lord's Prayer*

## Prayer Station 5

*Forgive us our sins as we forgive  
those who sin against us.*

- Offer confession for the times when you have not reached out with love, and for when our hearts have been fearful.
- Ask for new boldness to talk about the difference Jesus has made in our lives.



# *Praying the Lord's Prayer*

Prayer Station 6

*Lead us not into temptation but  
deliver us from evil.*

- Pray for some of the needs of our parish and community.
- Ask God to show you 5 people to pray for so they may encounter Jesus.
- How can you allow God to order your steps, to lead you along the pathways you should follow rather than those that are easy or most appealing.

## Prayer Station 7

*For the kingdom, the power, and the  
glory are yours, now and for ever.*

- Pray for a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit on His church this Pentecost season.
- Pray that many people will discover the truth about Jesus across our community, the nation, and the world.
- Pray for God's blessing on each other, and on every church and every household in our community.
